In case of a school employee, the school or school facility may process personal data from this completed form on the basis of Article 6 section 1 letter e) and article 9 section 2 letter c), g), i) regarding the GDPR to the extent set out here, in order to ensure the protection of health of children and students and a safe and hygienically satisfactory environment.

¹ person is considered to be a fully vaccinated person: (a) at least 14 days but not more than 9 months after the application of the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine with a two-dose schedule; (b) at least 21 days but not more than 9 months after the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine with a single dose schedule has been administered, or (c) for at least 14 days and not more than 9 months after the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine has been administered, if the first dose of COVID-19 vaccination has been administered within 180 days of COVID-19.
